<b>TICKETING</b>	<p><b>All guests should have their physical ticket ready</b> for entry to the stadium upon arrival.</p> <p><b>Collections are available at the ticket pod in the Main Car Park,</b> next to the club shop.</p> <p><b>The point of entry will be detailed on each ticket.</b></p> <p><b>Extra tickets will be available for purchase on match day</b> from the ticket offices which open at 9.00am</p>												
<b>SAFETY AND SECURITY</b>	<p>Please note there will be enhanced security searches in place for this match and all supporters need to be aware of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Supporters are encouraged to arrive early</b> to avoid delays in entry due to enhanced searching</li> <li>• <b>100% bag search and random pat-downs</b> will be in place at turnstiles</li> <li>• <b>Do not bring large bags / rucksacks.</b> All bags will be searched regardless of size</li> </ul> <p><b>Please note persistent standing is not permitted within the stadium during the match.</b> We kindly ask all supporters to abide by this rule and respond to the safety instructions from the stewarding team so that all guests can have an enjoyable experience.</p>												

	<p><b>Regulations regarding foul and abusive language</b> -We are obliged to remind all fans of the club’s policy in relation to foul and abusive language around the stadium: The club’s policy states that “The use of threatening behaviour, foul or abusive language, as well as racial, homophobic or discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment, is strictly forbidden and will result in arrest and/or ejection from the ground. The club may impose a ban for one or More matches.”</p> <p><b>Zero tolerance policy on pyrotechnics</b> - Wycombe Wanderers would like to remind fans of its zero-tolerance policy in relation to the use of pyrotechnics inside the stadium on match-days.</p> <p>Any supporter found to be carrying or letting off a pyrotechnic inside Adams Park will receive an immediate long-term ban from the stadium. This applies to flares, smoke bombs and fireworks.</p> <p>This policy is in line with guidelines issued by FIFA, UEFA, the FA and EFL which also state that details of anyone committing such an offence will be forwarded to the police and could lead to criminal proceedings.</p>
<p><b>GUEST SERVICES</b></p>	<p><b>Re-Entry</b> Should spectators leave the Stadium, they will not be allowed to re-enter, unless under exceptional circumstances such as on medical grounds. Please seek the support of a safety steward if this situation arises.</p> <p><b>Cashpoint</b> There is no cashpoint at the stadium, so fans are advised to bring sufficient cash with them. The nearest free cashpoint is at the Tesco store, around 10 minutes' walk away.</p>
<p><b>ALCOHOL</b></p>	<p><b>Alcohol will not be on sale in general admission areas.</b></p> <p><b>Alcohol service will be managed with the following plan in place in hospitality areas:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Alcohol is not permitted into the seating bowl</li> <li>▪ 4 x drinks per person at time of service</li> <li>▪ Challenge 25 will be in force</li> <li>▪ No alcohol in public areas</li> </ul>

<b>FLAGS</b>	<p><b>Supporters may bring a flag into the ground WITHOUT permission if:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The flag is smaller than 250cm in size at the widest or longest point.</li><li>▪ It does not have an attached flag pole</li><li>▪ In the case of an attached flag pole, it is made from wood and plastic only and is no longer than 1 metre in length and 1cm in diameter.</li><li>▪ There is no advertising or commercial message on the flag</li><li>▪ It does not contain any abusive or defamatory message</li></ul> <p><b>**Please note that flag poles made of metal are not permitted inside the stadium, no matter what size or length the flag / pole is.</b></p>
<b>TRAVEL</b>	<p><b>By Road:</b> Traffic is often heavy around Adams Park on match-days so drivers are advised to allow plenty of time. Adams Park is signposted from the M40 with brown football / stadium signs. Leave the M40 at Junction 4 and take the A4010 (John Hall Way, signposted Aylesbury). Cross over three small roundabouts into New Road continuing down the hill to two mini roundabouts at the bottom. Turn sharp left at the first into Lane End Road and continue to the next mini roundabout at which turn right into Hillbottom Road. Adams Park is situated at the very end of the road..</p> <p><b>By Rail:</b> The nearest railway station is High Wycombe, which is approximately 2.5 miles from the stadium. Chiltern Railways operate services to High Wycombe from Birmingham Snow Hill to London Marylebone, Aylesbury and Banbury. Visit the Chiltern Railways website for timetables and further information.</p> <p><b>General Parking:</b> There are limited parking facilities at the ground and access before and after the game is often busy.</p> <p>Upper tier parking in the official club car park is charged at £5 on a first-come-first-served basis. Please note that the capacity of the upper car park may be reduced in adverse weather conditions. Once the upper tier car park reaches capacity, drivers will be redirected by stewards to alternative parking sites at industrial units along Hillbottom Road on the approach to the stadium.</p> <p>Street parking is also available in the vicinity of the ground, however, supporters are warned that traffic wardens patrol the area regularly and we would ask you to park sensibly, respecting our neighbours in the Sands area.</p>
